What is Meetup?

Meetup is the world's largest network of local groups.

Meetup makes it easy for anyone (including the Calgary Ski Club) to organize a local group or find one of the thousands already meeting up face-to-face. More than 9,000 groups get together in local communities each day.

What does this mean for the Calgary Ski Club?

The Calgary Ski Club has joined other local groups on Meetup to facilitate events and activities.

Instead of registering for trips and events at www.calgaryskiclub.org, you'll be registering for trips at www.meetup.com. For all trips (both day trips and extended trips), you'll log in to the Calgary Ski Club's Meetup groups and register for the event.

Why are we using Meetup?

Our club offers some amazing events. Meetup offers an easy way of sharing these events with other like-minded individuals, who are just waiting to join us. It makes event posting substantially easier, while increasing ways members can find out about trips, and sharing photos afterwards.

After the 2015/2016 trial, the membership approved continuing with Meetup.com at the 2016 AGM. To better serve our members, the membership at the September 2017 SGM agreed to create separate Meetup sites for the different activities within the Club. This allows each member to choose which type of event they want to receive information on. Questions, comments and feedback are greatly welcome! What is the benefit of using Meetup?

1. Meetup makes it easier for group leaders to organize events and facilitate conversations in one place.
2. Notifications for upcoming trips and events come to your inbox, no need for you to go searching for the calendar of events.
3. In real-time, you can view how many people who will be attending a trip or event that you're interested in attending.

4. After trips and events, photos can be uploaded and shared on Meetup for those who attended, no more email exchanging!

Do I need to signup for Meetup?

Yes – however, it’s simple and you can find out other activities going on in Calgary at the same time. Sign up for the Calgary Ski Club Meetup groups you’re interested in at:

Why do I need to sign up on calgaryskiclub.org and meetup.com?

The Calgary Ski Club registration holds personal information, including your name, email address, mailing address, CSC points etc. This is used for club communication, mailing out membership cards, insurance, etc. and is not collectible by Meetup alone.

Meetup will only be used to facilitate event management and communication. This serves as your year-round source for trip and event details and serves as a communication forum between members.

How do I pay for trips?

Extended trips and special events may carry an additional cost to your membership fees. These can be paid for using PayPal – which also accepts credit card – when you register for the paid event on the Calgary Ski Club Meetup group.

I’m getting too many emails from Meetup! Make it stop!

There are two places you can disable emails you receive from Meetup and from the Calgary Ski Club Meetup group.

To reduce the emails from Meetup, uncheck all notifications you don’t want here:
